**Consultation on the five-year review of: RS800 Managing Drivers on Routes Undergoing Significant Change Issue 1**

RSSB and the TOM Standards Committee has recently undertaken a five-year review of the above document and considers:

RS800 Issue 1 should be reviewed with industry to consult on the findings. Industry is also asked for their views on the recommendation to conduct a review of available literature; research how the document has been applied; update or create new case studies where possible; and Reformat information into 2 parts: a guidance note, and broader guidance for the RSSB website.

Network Rail submitted a research idea to look at opportunities to help manage and support drivers on routes undergoing significant change. This led to the publication of RS800 in December 2015.

We would like to have your comments on the outcome of the review and to know of issues that may have a bearing on the way forward for RS800 Issue 1 by **11/07/22**, we may not be able to respond to comments received after that date.
