Consultation on the revised document GEGN8502 issue two, Operation of Urban Rail Vehicles on or adjacent to GB Mainline Infrastructure

The Rolling Stock Standards Committee (RST SC) has considered the business case for change to revise the guidance note above. It would welcome your comments on this change.

This consultation concerns light and very light rail, metro, tram-train and trams and should be brought to the attention of operators of those vehicles as well as infrastructure managers and project entities.
